Note:

'Start' Consonant pieces (dark blue) and 'End' Consonant pieces (light blue) do not have the same letter combinations. This is because most 3 letter CVC words do not end in f, l, w, k, r, h, y, j, v or z. 3 letter words ending in these letters would be digraphs rather than single consonants, as they are 2 letters (graphemes) making the 1 sound (phoneme). Examples include jaw, for, fur, toy, few.
